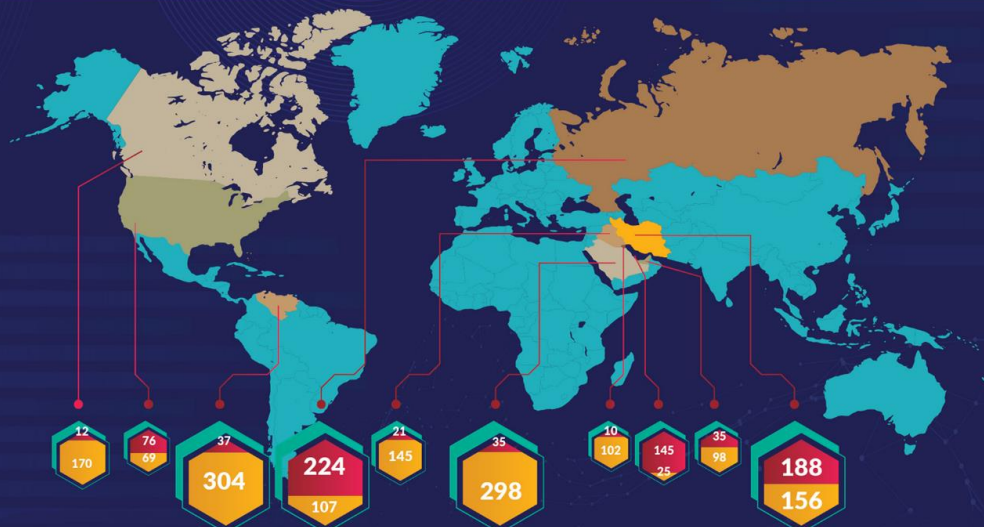

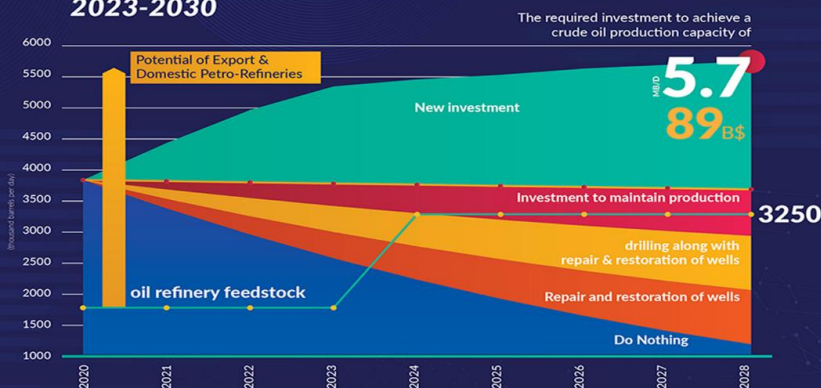

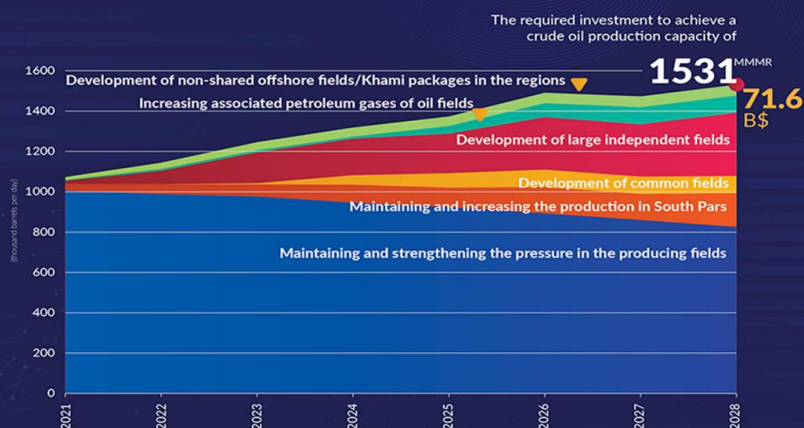

# Post Show Report

(summary of the report of the 27th exhibition)



The 27th international oil, gas, refining and petrochemical exhibition from May 17th to 20th, 2023 with the presence of more than 1700 domestic and foreign companies in the form of 20 exhibition halls with a useful area of 36 thousand square meters and an open space of 6 thousand square meters was held in Tehran Permanent International Fairground.

During the 4 days of this exhibition, more than 30,000 domestic and foreign visitors visited the exhibition and many business negotiations, specialized meetings and get-togethers were held in the public and private sectors.



The official opening ceremony of this exhibition was held in the presence of Mohammad Mokhber, First Vice President, Javad Owji, Minister of Oil, and high-ranking domestic and foreign officials. Also, high-ranking domestic and foreign officials attended this exhibition as follows:

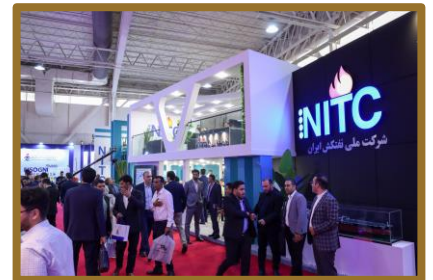
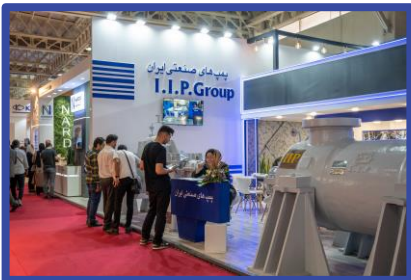
